Theft Ring Disrupted After Felony Arrests

After a week-long investigation, charges have been filed in several cases of burglaries that have occurred over the last few months near rural Elgin and rural Oelwein.

A pair of felony charges has been brought forth, along with a laundry list of additional charges.

A deputy with the Fayette County Sheriff's Office stopped a vehicle Sept. 20 and discovered stolen property in the back seat.

A search warrant was issued on the vehicle, and upon searching, more evidence of stolen property was located.

Kaben Allen Schmelzer, 34, of Oelwein, was arrested and charged with two counts of burglary in the third degree, a Class "D" felony; theft in the third degree, an aggravated misdemeanor; theft in the fifth degree, a simple misdemeanor; two counts of trespassing, a simple misdemeanor, and possession of drug paraphernalia,

a simple misdemeanor. Joining Schmelzer in facing charges is Steffeny Ann Rose, 39, of Arlington. She is being charged with two counts of burglary in the third degree, a Class "D" felony; theft in the third degree, an aggravated misdemeanor; theft in the fifth degree, a simple misdemeanor; two counts of trespassing, a simple misdemeanor, and possession of drug paraphernalia, a simple misdemeanor).

Viktor Bubiy, also of Allamakee County, was the owner of the vehicle.

State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company, of no address listed, is also named as a defendant
