The Board of Supervisors met at 9:30 a.m. February 19, 2018, with all members present.

Bethany Jordan, Martin Gardner Architecture. Met with the Board for the bid opening on the roof project. Moved by Thompson and seconded by Beard to open the public hearing. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote. Jordan opened and reviewed the bid specifications from four contractors. She will compile a bid tabulation and reference for next week's meeting when the Board is expected to award the contract. No written or verbal comments were received. Moved by Kuhn and seconded by Ashbacher to close the public hearing. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote. Moved by Thompson and seconded by Kuhn to consider all four bids under advisement including Matt Construction who will be contacted by Jordan to supply a completion date which was not included on the bid form. Motion carried unanimously.
