## BOARD PROCEEDINGS 08.28.2023 Winneshiek County BOS

### BOARD MINUTES MONDAY AUGUST 28, 2023

The Board of Supervisors met at 9:30am August 28, 2023 with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited, and the meeting was called to order.

Chad Wilkins and Kevin Hanson, Iowa Rotocast Plastics, met with the Board to inquire about the potential sale of a parcel of land in Freepoint to IRP to facilitate their installation of a solar array. The Board will check with other departments on the current and future use of the land, and discuss with the County Attorney the procedure if they wish to proceed.

Moved by Vick and seconded by Faldet to approve the consent agenda which includes the minutes of the last meeting, the claims filed with the Board, and the liquor licenses for Peppercorn Food Company and K-Town Tap. Motion carried unanimously.

Brenda Kretzler, County Treasurer, met with the Board to inform them that due to lack of public utilizing the service, the County Treasurer's office will discontinue administration of the CDL skills testing. DOT regulations require testers to administer ten tests per year to remain certified, and they have only had two people request tests since February.

Andy Van Der Maaten, County Attorney, met with the Board to discuss county issues.

Moved by Vermace and seconded by Kelsay to issue the Request for Qualifications for a search firm to help recruit and hire a County Engineer, with a due date for the RFO response of September 22. Motion carried unanimously.

Nick Rissman, Interim County Engineer, and Jeff Kuboushek, Road Maintenance Superintendent, met with the Board to discuss road matters.

Moved by Vick and seconded by Kelsay to adopt resolution 24-06, setting a public hearing on the vacation of the unused portion of Horn Hollow Road for September 25, 2023 at 9:30 a.m. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote. Public notice will be published as required.

Moved by Vick and seconded by Vermace to adopt resolution 24-07, authorizing an interfund loan from the General Fund to the Road Fund in the amount of \$600,000. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

Moved by Vermace and seconded by Faldet to adopt resolution 24-08, designating Rissman as the authorized engineer for Winneshiek County road projects managed through the DOT. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

Moved by Vermace and seconded by Faldet to authorize the purchase by the road department of a John Deere 6120M-2VD for \$98,000 and the Diamond Mowing equipment for \$29,598. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Faldet and seconded by Vermace to adjourn to 9:30am Tuesday, September 5, 2023. Motion carried unanimously.

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## PUBLIC NOTICE Dairyland Power Cooperative

### ELECTRIC POWER LINES AND GRAIN BINS DON'T MIX!

Please contact your local electric cooperative/utility if you plan to build a grain bin in the vicinity of an electric distribution line or electric transmission line.

Dairyland Power Cooperative owns and operates transmission lines in Northeastern Iowa, which provide electrical energy to local rural electric cooperatives and municipalities. Those transmission lines are operated at voltages that greatly exceed local distribution and service lines that may be located on your property. Dairyland will provide assistance in planning the placement of the grain bin near our transmission line to provide a safe environment for everyone working and living around grain bins.

The State of Iowa requires specific clearances for electric lines around grain bins, with different standards for those filled by portable and permanent augers, conveyors and elevators. The drawings show specific clearances required for each scenario.

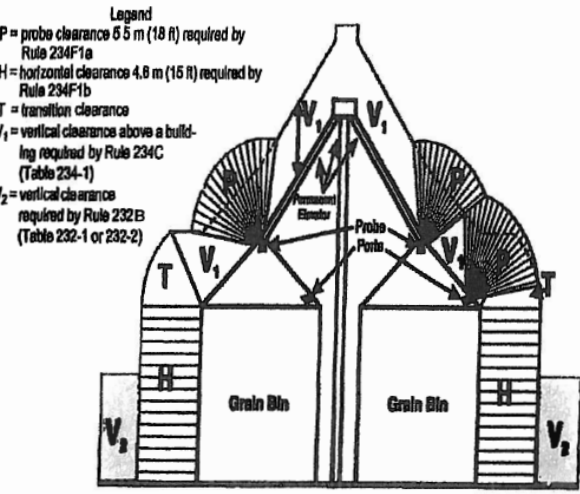


Figure 234-4(a)—Clearance envelope for grain bins filled by permanently installed augers, conveyors, or elevators

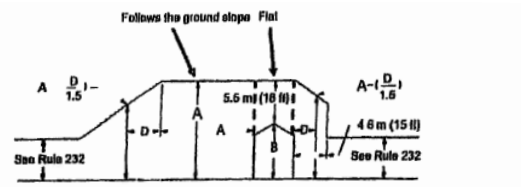


Figure 234-4(b)—Clearance envelope for grain bins filled by portable augers, conveyors, or elevators

According to the Iowa Electric Safety Code found in Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 199 - 25.2(3)b., your local electric utility may refuse to provide electric service to any grain bin built near an existing electric line which does not provide the clearances required by The American National Standards Institutes (ANSI)C2-2017 "National Electrical Safety Code," Rule 234F. This Paragraph "b" shall apply only to grain bins loaded by portable augers, conveyors or elevators built after September 9, 1992, or to grain bins loaded by permanently installed augers, conveyors or elevator systems installed after December 24, 1997. (As adopted by the Iowa Utilities Board)

Dairyland Power Cooperative is required by the Iowa Utilities Board to provide this annual notice to farmers, farm lenders, grain bin merchants, and city and county zoning officials.
