by Schmitt and seconded by Steinlage at 7:03 PM to adopt the following Resolution: WHEREAS Iowa Code provides greater flexibility to transfer excess

funds to other specified purposes; WHEREAS The Board has \$9,604.21 in categorical funds in which the program that had the funding has been discontinued or the district does not need the funds in those areas. The funds are the Iowa Core Curriculum Professional Development Fund (\$7,459.37), the Mentoring Fund (\$430.84), and the Home School Assistance fund (\$1,714). Furthermore, the board certifies that all statutory obligations have been met with these programs and funds and these amounts are excess funds. Furthermore, the board directs these funds to be used to purchase supplies for the buildings as needed for their operations. NOW THEREFORE; be it resolved on the 13th day of September, 2021

Moved by Shatek and seconded by Schmitt to approve the financial reports and bills. General Fund \$86,675.44, Hot Lunch \$9,491.28, Clearing \$11,903.70, PPEL/Capital \$33,743.04. Carried unanimously.

Senior Career students observed the meeting as part of a requirement for their class. The board welcomed them. Mrs. Milbrandt thanked the board members for volunteering and serving on our school board. Harley Baumler updated the board on FFA

news. There are 68 FFA members at Turkey Valley.

Mr. Jurrens opened and shared the bus bids with the board. Moved by Shatek and seconded by Schmitt to approve the low bid from Hoglund Bus Company @ \$101,259.00. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Steinlage and seconded by Schmitt to approve the Annual Goals for 2021-2022: Goal 1- 76% of 1st through 3rd graders will be proficient on the Spring FAST Reading Assessment; Goal 2- 69% of 8th graders will be proficient on the ISASP Science Test (Last year was 67%; and Goal 3- 60% of 11th grade students will be proficient on the ISASP Math Test (Last year was 58%). Carried unanimously.

Licensed professionals would come to Turkey Valley and provide counseling, with parent permission, during the school day. The ESSER III plan has money allocated for this service. Carried unanimously.

Turkey Valley will continue as we have been doing, masks are not required but encouraged. The board did a short survey in regards to the replacement of the Keystone AEA administration.
